Job Description

This position is for a professional land surveyor responsible for the successful execution of projects in Idaho and surrounding States. The Project Surveyor will report to and work at the direction of the Geospatial Data Solutions Regional Survey Manager in the CH2M Boise, Idaho office. The project surveyor will manage projects or major project tasks, supervise staff, mentor subordinates, prepare specifications and oversee the activities of subcontractors and/or partner companies in both field and office activities. The project surveyor will also support business development efforts working with and at the direction of the Regional Survey Manager, and CH2M HILL engineering and business development staff and clients. These efforts will include developing the scope of work, project approach, and estimate of costs, often in short time frames.

Field duties may include direction and coordination of one or more survey parties on projects of varying size including larger, complex projects (sometimes in remote locations), and often utilizing static and/or RTK GPS technology, electronic total stations, and digital leveling techniques. These projects can include geodetic control surveys, R/W and boundary tasks, photo control surveys, electronic field data collection, hydrographic surveys, utility location surveys, and/or GIS data collection tasks. Air travel and the use of rental vehicles, boats, and company vehicles are common. Larger projects are often performed with additional staff from other CH2M HILL offices and with subcontractors.

Office duties will include research, preparation, and planning, along with data reduction and final processing of the field activities stated above. The Project Surveyor will be responsible for quality control, supervision of staff, and the successful execution of assigned projects and tasks. On projects that include boundary resolution and R/W acquisition, the Project Surveyor may be required to prepare Records of Survey, legal descriptions and plats, and other legal documents for recording. Mentoring of subordinates is expected, along with the assignment and delegation of responsible tasks to those employees. Anticipate that 25%-plus of project fieldwork will require travel and could involve occasional overseas trips. Projects on military bases can be expected. The successful candidate

must be a US citizen and will be required to submit personal data for admission passes and security clearances.
