Job Description

The Survey Manager will manage survey staff and mentor subordinates in CH2M HILL's Boise, ID office. The successful candidate will also prepare specifications and manage the activities of subcontractors and/or partner companies in both field and office activities.

The Surveyor Manager will be responsible for business development efforts working with and supporting CH2M HILL engineering and business development staff and clients. These efforts will include developing scopes of work, estimating costs, and proposal preparation, often in short time frames. Office duties will include; research, preparation, planning, and managing survey mapping projects. Certain projects will require the Survey Manager to be CH2M HILL's surveyor of record in responsible charge of work involving boundary resolution and R/W acquisition, the preparation of Records of Surveys, legal descriptions and plats, and other documents that may also require stamping, signing, and recording. A strong background in GPS technology and CAD\CAE software is a plus.

Field duties will include direction and coordination of one or more survey parties on larger, complex projects (sometimes in remote locations), often utilizing static and RTK GPS technology, electronic total stations, and digital leveling techniques. These projects can include geodetic control surveys, R/W and boundary tasks, photo control surveys, electronic field data collection, hydrographic surveys, utility location surveys, and/or GIS data collection tasks. Air travel and the use of rental vehicles, boats, and company vehicles are common. Larger projects are often performed with additional staff from other CH2M HILL offices and through the use of subcontractors. Office duties will include research, preparation, and planning of surveying and mapping projects/tasks, along with data reduction and final processing for the field activities stated above.

Mentoring of subordinates is expected, along with the assignment and delegation of responsible tasks to those employees. Anticipate that 25%-plus of project fieldwork will require travel and could involve occasional overseas trips. Projects on military bases can be expected and the successful candidate

must be a US citizen and will be required to submit personal data for admission passes and security clearances.
