JOB SUMMARY	Assists in surveying land by performing the following duties;
ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES	Includes the following. Other duties may be assigned. Holds level or stadia rod at designated points to assist in determining elevations and laying out stakes for mapmaking, construction, land, and other surveys. Marks points of measurement with elevation, station number, or other identifying mark as instructed by crew chief. Measures distance between survey points with steel or cloth tape or surveyor's chain. Places stakes at designated points and drives them into the ground as instructed by crew chief. Cuts and clears brush and trees from line of survey. Performs other duties as instructed by the crew chief. Performs occasional general labor around building as needed. Able to work Saturdays and overtime if needed.
QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS	To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE	Minimum of a high school/GED Minimum 0-2 years relevant experience. Bachelors or Associates Degree in surveying preferred but not required.
REASONING ABILITY	Ability to apply commonsense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions. Must have the ability to learn and operate various equipment related to surveying such as data collectors, total stations, and levels. No knowledge of this equipment is needed prior to employment.
MATHEMATICAL SKILLS	Ability to do simple math skills such as addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. Has an understanding of algebra and geometry.

Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions. Ability to write simple correspondence.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS
The physical demands here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. WORK ENVIRONMENT
While performing the duties of this job, the employee regularly works in outside weather conditions. The employee occasionally works near heavy machinery and equipment and is occasionally exposed to fumes or airborne particles. The noise level in the work environment can be very quiet to extremely loud at times. Necessary safety equipment required for certain situations will be provided.
