

13. You are performing a dependent resurvey in T. 15 N., R. 26 E., sec. 8 (Leadore area), as originally surveyed by John B. David in 1884. During a corner search at a 1/4 sec. cor. position, you recover a stone, firmly set, which closely matches the dimensions, as noted in the official field notes. However these marks actually appear to have been made with a punch (versus the usual chisel marks). Additionally the marks resemble a reversed “4”. See photo. below.



Is this stone something you would accept as the original John B. David corner position?
